

# 20 Useful Photoshop Shortcuts!

There are many different ways of doing things in Photoshop, so many in fact that for the new user of the program it can be a bit bewildering. One of the greatest boons to using the program efficiently is to learn some of the timesaving keyboard shortcuts.

Here I've provided you with a quick list of the shortcuts that I personally use most often. Indeed I use these so frequently that they are now second nature. Image size	Image/Image	Size Alt+Ctrl+I
Canvas Size	Image/Canvas Size	Alt+Ctrl+C
New Layer via Copy	Layer/New/Layer via Copy	Ctrl+J
Merge Visible	Layer/Merge Visible	Shift+Ctrl+E

## Selection Tools:

Marquee Tool		M
Lasso Tool		L
Quick Selection Tool		W
Deselect	Select/Deselect	Ctrl+D

## Using Brushes:

Brush Tool		B
Changing brush on the fly:		Left Square Bracket key [ for smaller brush diameter Right Square Bracket key ] for larger brush diameter Shift + [ for softer brush edge Shift + ] for harder brush edge

## Brush colours

Default black and white		D
Switching foreground and background brush colours		X

Clone Stamp		S
Healing brush		J

Crop Tool		C
Free Transform	Edit/Free Transform	Ctrl+T
Save for Web and Devices.	File/Save for Web and Devices	Alt+Shift+Ctrl+S
